UNIT/S OVERVIEW

ArbTrack delivers a range of nationally recognised units relevant to the Electricity Supply Industry (ESI), utility vegetation management, emergency response, and field operations.

Units may be undertaken individually, to maintain industry currency, or as part of broader qualification pathways including UET20321 Certificate II in ESI – Powerline Vegetation Control.

Important Course Information

- Training includes nationally recognised units of competency.
- Participants who successfully complete the required assessment activities will receive a Statement of Attainment for completed units.
- As assessment is competency-based, delivery duration may vary depending on participant experience, performance and group size.

SUITABILITY

This training may be suitable for individuals seeking nationally recognised training relevant to Electricity Supply Industry (ESI)

Units may be suitable for:

- Utility vegetation workers
- Arborists
- Ground crews
- EWP operators
- Contractors
- Vegetation management personnel
- Supervisors and team leaders (where applicable)
- Existing workers seeking formal recognition of skills
- Individuals undertaking units to maintain industry currency, compliance or employer-required training

Training may be undertaken:

- as individual units of competency,
- to support employer or workplace requirements,
- to maintain industry capability, or as part of broader qualification pathways.
- Suitability, entry requirements and pre-requisites will vary depending on the unit/s selected.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Entry requirements vary depending on the unit selected.

Participants should:

- Have suitable physical capacity to undertake practical activities where applicable
- Possess basic literacy and numeracy skills
- Be able to follow workplace safety instructions and procedures
- Meet any unit-specific pre-requisite requirements

Some units may also require:

- Current employment or workplace access
- Existing nationally recognised units of competency
- Employer or network authorisation requirements

- Completion of a unit does not automatically result in employer authorisation or network approval where additional requirements apply.

EQUIPMENT & PPE

- Participants will be required to supply personal protective equipment (PPE) and/or industry-specific equipment depending on the unit selected and practical activities undertaken.
- Detailed requirements and pre-course information will be provided during enrolment.
- Where participant-supplied equipment is used during training or assessment, equipment must be inspected and approved prior to use.
